- Fractions, decimals and percentages
- Shape and space
- Common measures

COURSE DURATION AND START DATE:

Both courses are part-time day or part-time evening courses. They start in September, January, and March. Please contact us for further details.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

There are no entry requirements for this course, but you will need to meet with the tutor before joining the course.

CAREER PROGRESSION AND FUTURE OPPORTUNITIES:

This course is designed to help you gain qualifications from Entry Level through to Level 2 (which is the basic requirement for many jobs and courses).

This course is a full Level 2 qualification which will enable you to gain access to the course you want or the job you want.



» GROW

Our 'Grow' course helps you get back on track and take your first steps towards a new you and a new career.

We believe that there is potential in everyone. You may not have done so well at school or are not expecting to get the GCSE results you need for your chosen course but don't worry, we have the answer.

The course is split into 2 and is designed to help you improve your skills so that you can get the most out of the opportunities available to you.

» STAGE 1

You will get to do at least 2 different tasters, so whether you like being outdoors, working with children, or if you prefer media and acting, there is something for everyone. By the end of this programme you will have loads of confidence and be ready to move on to the next stage.

COURSE DURATION AND START DATE:

A full-time 18 week course, running over 4 days per week, starting in September, November, January.

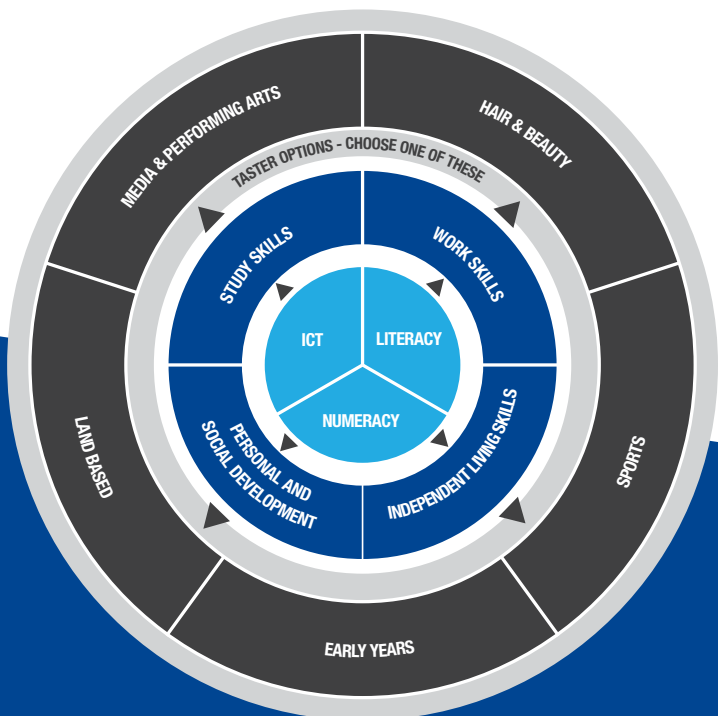
ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

A willingness to further develop literacy or numeracy skills.
