

Accommodation FAQs

Who can apply for Accommodation at BMC?

Accommodation is available for students of Brooksby Melton College who are completing either a Level 2 or Level 3 course at the Brooksby Campus. There is also limited accommodation available for Undergraduate students.

Where is the Accommodation located?

Our Halls of Residence are located on the Brooksby campus, within the grounds of our 850-acre country estate. Brooksby is situated in between the town of Melton Mowbray and the city of Leicester.

What room types are available?

Within the Halls of Residence, there are a mixture of single and bunked rooms.

What facilities are there in the Halls of Residence?

Each accommodation block provides shared toilets and shower rooms for residents, with access to fully equipped kitchens. There is a common room in each accommodation block providing a place to relax.

How much is the accommodation?

The Costs for a single room in academic year 20/21 are £5000 per academic year, and a shared room is £4200 for the academic year. This is for a fully catered service (3 meals per day), Monday to Friday, term time only. All Accommodation charges are payable on a monthly basis in advance.

How many days per week can I be in accommodation?

The Halls of Residence are open from 5.30pm on Sunday and close each Friday at 5pm. You can be in accommodation five nights a week. The College may also offer a 7 day service for those students who do not wish to travel home each weekend (depending on numbers).

Do I receive meals as a resident at BMC?

Of course! All residents receive a meal package as part of their accommodation. Three meals a day (breakfast, lunch and evening meal) are freshly prepared by our chef and catering team for all residents.

Are staff on site during the evenings?

Yes! There is a dedicated team of Residential Duty Wardens who are on hand for all your needs. The team are experienced and skilled in supporting students within residential accommodation. The Accommodation Service ensures compliance within the National Minimum Standards for Accommodation of Students under 18, within Further Education Colleges.

When can I move in and when do we have to leave?

Residents usually move in just before their enrolment date at the start of the academic year and leave at the end of the academic year. Dates are flexible, designed to work around your course and give you peace of mind.

Can I share a room with someone I know who is also attending College?

We have a number of shared rooms within the Halls of Residence. Any special requests are raised an application stage. The Team do their best to meet all requests; however, we cannot always guarantee this.

What are the rooms like?

All rooms are comfortably furnished with either a single or bunk bed, wardrobe, handy shelves for your belongings, a desk to work from and cosy chairs. You can tour our accommodation at a Brooksby Campus open event. Visit www.brooksbymelton.ac.uk/events for a list of upcoming events.

Is there free WIFI?

Yes! There is free WIFI for all students in Accommodation and across campus.

What happens in the evening?

Residents of accommodation have exclusive access to a computer study room, classroom and quiet lounge. There are social spaces with darts, table tennis and pool. We also have a TV room with subscriptions to Sky Sports and Sky Movies! Monday-Thursday during the evening there is a shuttle bus service to local towns, shops and eateries. Staff are always on hand to provide study support and arrange activities. You can also take advantage of the onsite gym once you have attended and completed an induction session.

What support will I receive in Accommodation?

The Accommodation staff Team are on hand every evening during your stay. All residents have regular one to one review meetings. During the daytime, support is available from Student Services.

The computer room, classroom and quiet lounge are available every night exclusively for residents. The Accommodation Team are on hand to provide information, advice and guidance too!
